

Conference scope: This year there is no specific theme for the conference – we invite proposals discussing a wide range of topics related to modern languages including linguistics, didactics and literary studies. Both traditional and innovative approaches to the following fields of interest are welcome:

- Trans-Latio/Ratio
- The world in languages
- Method → Didactics
- The present day – Tradition and the future
- The world in literatures

Conference participants: We invite all PhD candidates as well as graduate and undergraduate students interested in presenting their scientific research to participate in the conference. Please note: undergraduate students are required to submit a report previously approved by a senior academic member of staff.

Conference languages: Although the language of the conference is Polish, it will also be possible to deliver the presentation in a language of choice.

Speaking time: 20 minutes with a further 10 minutes allocated for discussion.

Conference fee: 200 PLN; covers the cost of conference materials, lunch and coffee breaks as well as a peer-reviewed publication in a ranked volume.

For authors: The suggested maximum length of the paper submitted in any language of choice is 25,000 characters including spaces. Contributors are asked to follow the style-sheet.

Registration: Please submit a completed application form including an abstract (up to 800 characters including spaces) in Polish or English to transdyscyplinarnosc@gmail.com by **March 15th 2019**. You will receive a paper acceptance notification by **March 31st 2019**, followed by the detailed conference programme, as well as the bank account details needed to complete the registration.
